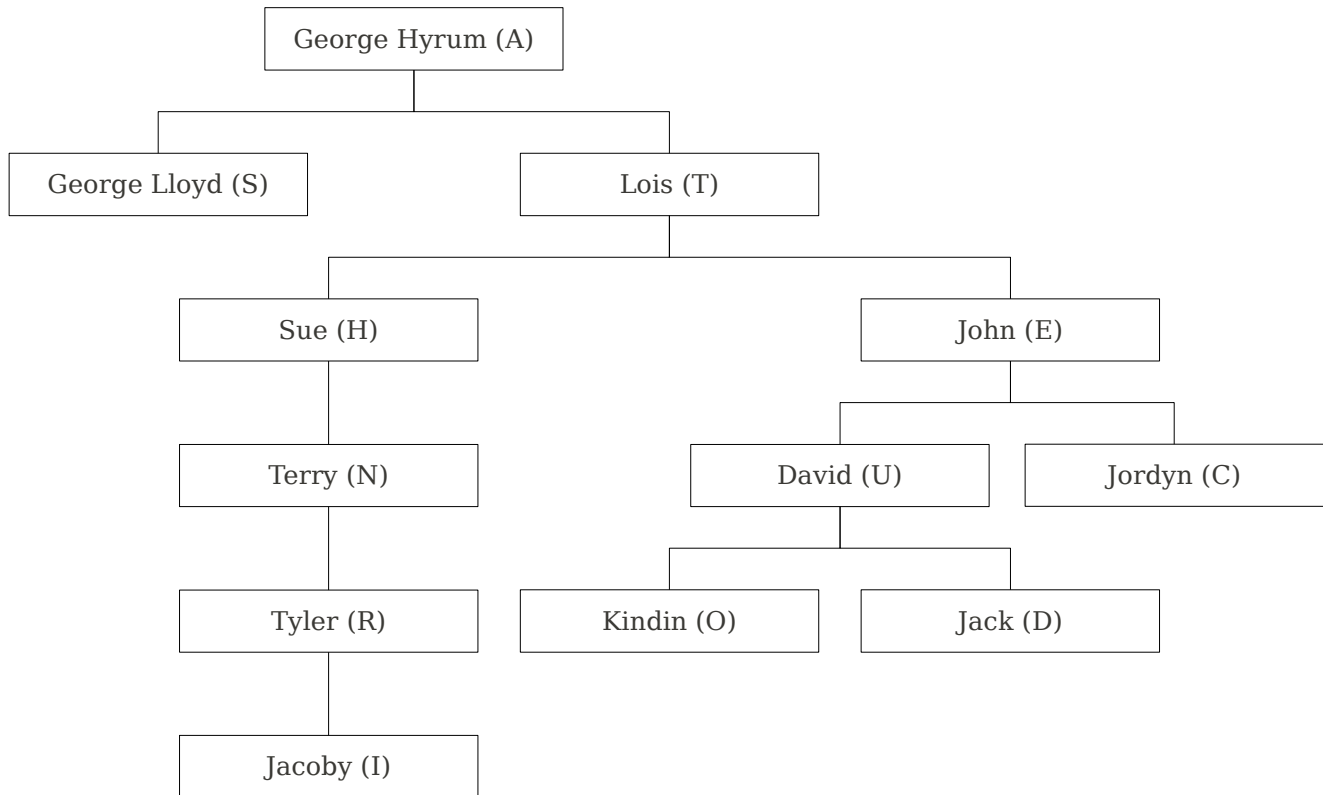




Cousins Maze

This diagram is a partial family tree.



The steps below lead you through a maze. If you start with the correct person and choose the correct alternative at each opportunity, then you'll be able to follow all the steps. If you choose incorrectly then you'll hit a dead end. - What letter is next to the name of the person that you did not use?

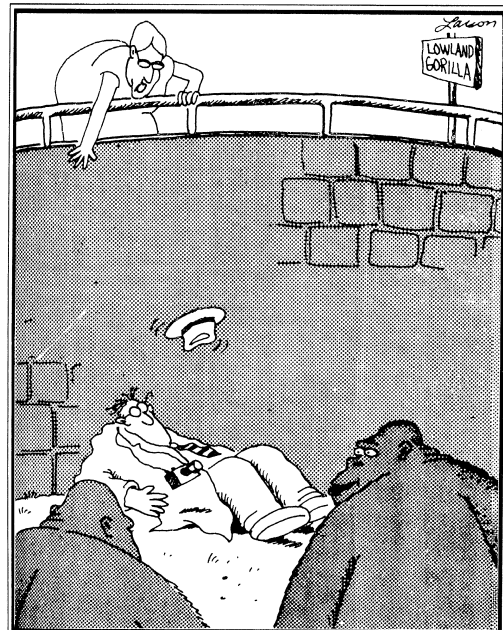

The Bible Dictionary describes revelation as “individual guidance for every person who seeks for it.” Did you know that modern revelations even contain the solutions to puzzles? An important ten-letter instruction is buried somewhere in the text of the Family Proclamation. This message can only be found if you read the words from top to bottom, not from left to right.

THE FAMILY PROCLAMATION TO THE WORLD THE FIRST PRESIDENCY AND COUNCIL OF THE TWELVE APOSTLES OF THE CHURCH OF JESUS CHRIST OF LATTER-DAY SAINTS, THE FIRST PRESIDENCY AND THE COUNCIL OF THE TWELVE APOSTLES OF THE CHURCH OF JESUS CHRIST OF LATTER-DAY SAINTS, SOLEMNLY PROCLAIM THAT MARRIAGE BETWEEN A MAN AND A WOMAN IS ORDAINED OF GOD AND THAT THE FAMILY IS CENTRAL TO THE CREATOR'S PLAN FOR THE ETERNAL DESTINY OF HIS CHILDREN. ALL HUMAN BEINGS—MALE AND FEMALE—are created in the image of God. Each is a beloved spirit son or daughter of heavenly parents, and, as such, each has a divine nature and destiny. Gender is an essential characteristic of individual premortal, mortal, and eternal identity and purpose. In the premortal realm, spirit sons and daughters knew and worshiped God as their eternal Father and accepted His plan by which His children could obtain a physical body and gain earthly experience to progress toward perfection and ultimately realize their divine destiny as an heir of eternal life. The divine plan of happiness enables family relationships to be perpetuated beyond the grave. Sacred ordinances and covenants available in holy temples make it possible for individuals to return to the presence of God and for families to be united eternally. The first commandment that God gave to Adam and Eve pertained to their potential for parenthood as husband and wife. We declare that God's commandment for His children to multiply and replenish the earth remains in force. We further declare that God has commanded that the sacred powers of procreation are to be employed only between man and woman, lawfully wedded as husband and wife. We declare the means by which mortal life is created to be divinely appointed. We affirm the sanctity of life and of its importance in God's eternal plan. Husband and wife have a solemn responsibility to love and care for each other and for their children. Children are an heritage of the Lord. Psalm 127:3 parents have a sacred duty to rear their children in love and righteousness, to provide for their physical and spiritual needs, to teach them to love and serve one another, to observe the commandments of God and to be law-abiding citizens wherever they live. Husband and wife—mothers and fathers—will be held accountable before God for the discharge of these obligations. The family is ordained of God. Marriage between man and woman is essential to His eternal plan. Children are entitled to birth within the bonds of matrimony, and to be reared by a father and a mother who honor marital vows with complete fidelity. Happiness in family life is most likely to be achieved when founded upon the teachings of the Lord. Jesus Christ's successful marriages and families are established and maintained on principles of faith, prayer, repentance, forgiveness, respect, love, compassion, work, and wholesome recreational activities. By divine design, fathers are to preside over their families in love and righteousness and are responsible to provide the necessities of life and protection for their families. Mothers are primarily responsible for the nurture of their children. In these sacred responsibilities, fathers and mothers are obligated to help one another as equal partners. Disability, death, or other circumstances may necessitate individual adaptation. Extended families should lend support when needed. We warn that individuals who violate covenants of chastity, who abuse spouse or offspring, or who fail to fulfill family responsibilities will one day stand accountable before God. Further, we warn that the disintegration of the family will bring upon individuals, communities, and nations the calamities foretold by ancient and modern prophets. We call upon responsible citizens and officers of government everywhere to promote those measures designed to maintain and strengthen the family as the fundamental unit of society. This proclamation was read by President Gordon B. Hinckley as part of his message at the General Relief Society meeting held September 23, 1995, in Salt Lake City, Utah.

My Dear Husband

The letter you wrote Wed. came Sat. An unusually short time. If they would all do that I might have a chance to keep things straight.

Ed was in the other day, he ask if we wanted to sell the dryland here at Ririe. I said, No he laughed that is what I expected he said then told me that he had received a letter of inquiry from a real estate co. in Twin Falls asking for the price of his land and ours. He had already written that he did not care to sell. He remarked that he expected his place here to be more valuable than his home ranch.

Dear Daddy, I have on Lloyds glasses. I play I am grandpa. I had a good time. We built a tent house with chairs and quilt. Mamma wont let me go out today. It is too cold. I locked Mammass desk and put the key in my pocket xoxoxox love Rendon

What do you think of John and Agnes going to Jerome. Agnes says it is about 40 miles beyond Rupert. She seems to think they have a wonderful place a good sized orchard of all kinds of fruit large and small appeals to her. There is a large house, water in the house but no electricity. They have one hundred sixty acres, John is there plowing, has been for three weeks sounds strange when our thermometer has been below zero a number of times. They are two and a half miles from the town. They don't seem to be discouraged in spite of this years not meeting expectations. She seems to like it.

Leah Ann is at Lizzies but her folks are all well. She is more than pleased with her house. After all the farm is the only place to live. Dr. Lee said they were unable to find a man in their ward who could go on a short term mission all live from day to day on their wages.

I think Leah's letter and drawing are the limit but guess I'll let it go. I haven't seen any babies howling around here however all are well. Be sure and write about the Xmas things. If possible by the fifteenth. Leah has not fussed quite so much about the watch lately but Lloyd is going to be heart broken if he doesn't get a tool chest of some kind. I have a doll put away for Lois that I drew as a premium at Foltz. Three weeks from tonight is Xmas eve. We would surely like to have you home. I think we can manage for just once under present conditions. Ray and Rendon don't say much about what they would like. Lloyd has a cupboard almost finished for Lois. He wants to make a wheel barrow for Rendon. I got a board from the lumber yard, the kind used for making boxes. He is doing fine with the cupboard.

I'm sure glad you don't have to be alone and cook for yourself. You do have company on a dry farm, However we all have to be tried some way are we would soon forget the blessings we have received and possibly take the credit to our selves for all that we accomplish. Praying the Lord to continue his many blessings while we are separated.

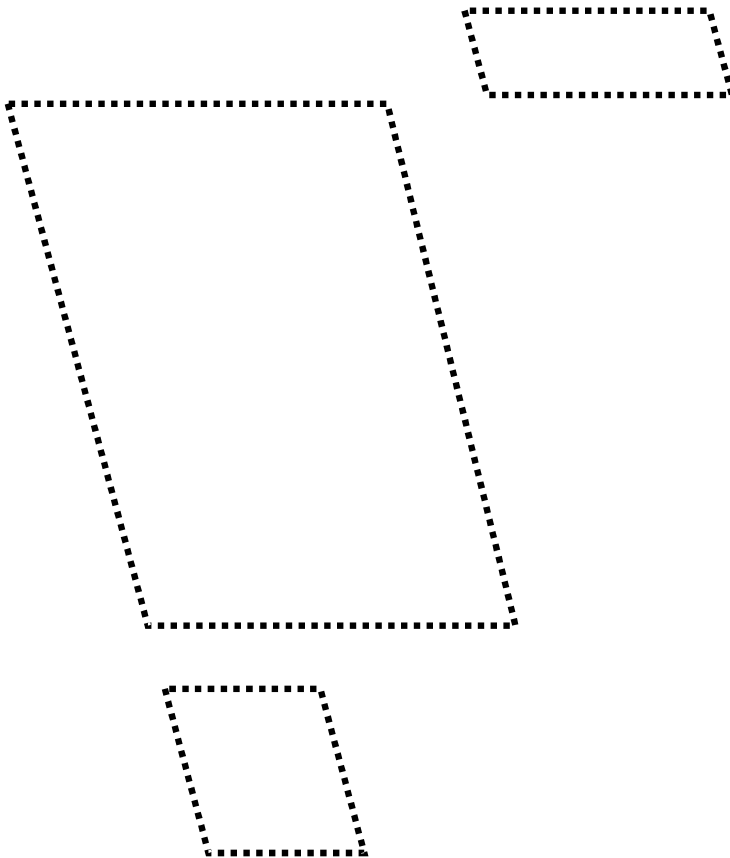
